

OTR Community Housing breaks ground on permanent supportive housing project: Gloria's Place. This 44-unit development is aimed for homeless people in Over-The-Rhine and will feature wraparound services including case management for people leaving homelessness.

NEW GRANTS

We're excited to announce that we have been awarded \$125,000 in grants from the Greater Cincinnati Foundation and the Robert & Adele Schiff Family Foundation for our **School-Based Housing Stability**, part of our Tenant Advocacy program. With these grants, we will focus directly on supporting School-Based Housing Stability in Price Hill elementary schools—specifically Oyler, Roberts, Carson, and Mt. Airy—to connect families with essential housing stability services.
